Item 1 of the Agenda: The meeting was called to order by Gardner at 7:00 PM.

Item 2 of the Agenda: On a motion by Clark and seconded by Gardner, the minutes of the regular and the special January meetings were approved unanimously. On a motion by Haschke and seconded by Leffingwell, the minutes of the February meeting were approved unanimously.

<u>Item 3 of the Agenda</u>: Clark moved and Gardner seconded to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion passed unanimously. The Bristols, owner of the property at 271 Tall Forest, claimed they did not receive a bill for dues. No **late penalties will be assessed.**

<u>Item 4 (i) of the Agenda</u>: A permit for a new house at 414 McAllister has been issued.

Item 4 (ii) of the Agenda: The Bristols want to put a manufactured shed on skids for equipment until they build. The unit will not be visible from the street and will be behind the house when it is built although the construction date is as yet undetermined. Tom McCulley will check on it and have a report at the April meeting.

<u>Item 5 (i) of the Agenda</u>: Reports on the Task List were postponed.

Item 5 (ii) of the Agenda:

- (c) No variance letter is needed for 396 Kaanapali.
- (d) Need variance letters to be written and filed for Rick Juarez and Mr. Heinz in Unit 6.
- (e) Still working on beautifying with regard to dead trees.
- (f) Streetlight issue pending.

<u>Item 6 (i) of the Agenda</u>: The Board needs a list of all replacement homes built within 18 months of the 2011 fire that may require variance letters to be written and filed.

Item 6 (ii) of the Agenda: Spending priorities have been established as follows: Completing Colovista to Timber Lane; paving cul-de-sacs on Woodland Court, Lakeside, Drive and River Forest; fire hydrants, and recreation area(s).

Item 6 (iii) of the Agenda: Board Liability Insurance is almost due for renewal. The premium is \$1500 a year with a \$2500 annual deductible. Discussion will resume at the April meeting.
